



Leaf Vacuum Collection Program 2025 – 2026
November 3, 2025 through March 6, 2026

Fall is upon us! The colorful leaves create a beautiful landscape but will eventually fall to the ground. Don't worry, the East Point Public Works Department in coordination with the Solid Waste Department is prepared to assist you with leaf collection. Please follow these simple instructions to ensure the program runs efficiently throughout the season:

- Leaves should preferably be placed in a container, watertight paper bag, or cardboard box. The weight **shall not** exceed fifty (50-lbs) pounds.
- An **unlimited** number of containerized or paper bagged leaves is permitted.
- Solid Waste will collect leaves that have been placed in **watertight paper bags, cardboard box or containers** on the same day as regular garbage collection. (**Code Ordinance, Chapter 2, Sec. 7-2002**).
- Leaves placed at the property line and the curb will be collected by the Public Works Department's Leaf Vacuum Collection team within forty-eight (48) hours of your regular garbage collection day. Leaves **must not** be piled on the sidewalk, on top of storm drain inlets or in the street to prevent stormwater system blockage.
- Failure to comply with the Leaf Vacuum/Collection Program may result in the issuance of a ***Notice of Violation*** and **Citation**.
