City of East Point Welcomes Renee Tyler as New Deputy City Manager

From McGehee AR to New York City and now the city of East Point, GA; Renee Tyler has been fortunate to experience life. After working for 25 years in Corporate America in New York City, Ms. Tyler changed careers in 2010 following her calling to public service. This career change began with her accepting an opportunity to work with the Speaker Pro Tempore of the New Jersey Assembly as his Chief of Staff.

In August 2025 Ms. Tyler began her role as Deputy City Manager for East Point, GA. In this role she focuses on senior operations and administrative functions as assigned by the City Manager.

Prior roles include the Deputy City Manager for the city of Webster Groves, MO, Senior Director of Metro Public Policy with Greater Saint Louis, Inc where she focused on policy initiatives specific to the city and county of St. Louis. Some of her assignments included a review of early childhood educational resources for ages 0-36 months, Lambert Airport's remodeling and the Rams settlement. City Administrator for Fulton, MO, Director of Community Services for the city of Eau Claire, WI. Community Services, Director of Transportation for Dubuque, IA (Ms. Tyler was the first person of color to hold this role in Iowa), Assistant Director of Public Works for Dubuque (again she was the first woman of color to hold this position in Iowa) and Manager of Fleet Acquisitions, Parts and Special Projects for the City of Little Rock.

Ms. Tyler obtained her Master of Public Service from the University of Arkansas William Clinton School of Public Service. The Clinton School presented her with its inaugural 2020 Public Service Excellence Award. She holds a BA in Social Welfare from the University of Arkansas Fayetteville.

She is a member of the American Public Works Association where she has served on the national committee for DEI and the APWA National Government Affairs Committee. In 2021 she received the APWA Public Service Award. She is also a member of the National Forum for Black Public Administrators and the International City County Managers Association.
