

2026 NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT, APPEAL, AND HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION INFORMATION

The Fulton County Board of Assessors mailed the 2026 Notice of Assessment on June 16, 2026.

- The Notice of Assessment is not a tax bill. It is the Fulton County Board of Assessors' determination of your property's taxable value for the 2026 tax year.
- The Notice of Assessment does not reflect any City of East Point Homestead Exemption that may be approved for the 2026 tax year. Homestead exemptions are applied later in the tax billing process
- Please note that property values are determined by the Fulton County Board of Assessors. The City of East Point does not determine property values and cannot process assessment appeals.
- Please follow the appeal instructions included with your Notice of Assessment and/or contact Fulton County Board of Assessors at 404-612-6440 with any questions.

The Notice of Assessment provides information regarding:

- The fair market value of your property
- The assessed value of your property
- Any changes made to your property's valuation
- Your right to appeal the valuation
